DESCRIPTION FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC

Conducting a criminal trial, during which the right conditions to decree are provided, is associated with incurring certain costs which are called the cost of criminal proceedings. The cost consists not only with costs directly related to the verdict, but also so-called the out of court costs connected with the guarantee of the appropriate conditions of judgement. The costs of the process are very complex and interesting problem, but not thoroughly discovered. The multifaceted analysis of costs has not yet been carried out, nobody has undertaken to estimate the actual costs of the proceedings and assess the rationality of the costs incurred in criminal procedure. Detailed examination of the cost of criminal proceedings in the light of the economic analysis of law will precisely evaluate the real value of the costs and their validity. Applying economic methods enable to look at costs from a perspective of their effectiveness and rationality. The cost of criminal proceedings in the light of the economic analysis of law will be helpful in determination the areas of the expenditures, in which it will be possible to save in the future the wherewithal from the national budget.
