The purpose of the research project is to present the activities of the League of Women in the field, at the level of voivodeships (Polish regions), poviats (Polish counties), towns, town districts, housing developments, workplaces, places of women's residence. During the project, the source materials collected in state archives (e.g. the Archives of Modern Records in Warsaw – Archiwum Akt Nowych w Warszawie, AAN; the Archives of the Institute of National Remembrance - Archivum Instytutu Pamieci Narodowej, Archiwum IPN; state archives in voivodeship cities) will be analyzed, press materials from periodicals published by the organization (e.g. "Nasza Praca" – Our Labour, "Zwierciadło" – Mirror) and literature of the subject (Polish publications and in foreign languages) will be analyzed. The aim of the project is to show the significance, evolution and development of the League of Women at the regional and local level of Poland and further throughout the country during the Polish People's Republic. The research results will be disseminated in Polish papers, publications and conferences in Poland and abroad. The research on the activities of the League of Women at regional and local level is an entirely novel one. Such research has not been implemented so far. The results of the project will significantly deepen the scientific knowledge on the history of Polish women in the 20th century, including Polish women's movements, and also on the still poorly elaborated themes concerning the history of women in the Polish People's Republic. The results of the project will correspond with the need to fill the gap related mainly to the contribution of Polish women to the history of women in Europe, especially in the Northeastern Europe after World War II.
